

### 1-2-3 CHA-CHA-CHA

(This score may be posted). A four-lady team will be combined using an "A", "B", "C" and "D", player. Each player will play their regular golf game with strokes posted on each hole. The score to be recorded as the Team Score will be One Best Net on the par 5's, Two Best Nets on the par 4's, Three Best Nets on the par 3's, and continue on through the 18 holes of play. The scores will be totaled and the lowest net team score will be declared the winners.

### ACE OF THE MONTH

Each player will play 18 holes of stroke play. Your full handicap will be deducted and the lowest net score will be the winner for the month. Once a player has won a monthly title she may only compete for the low net in her flight. Each Ace of the Month winner will be eligible to compete in the Ace of Aces Tournament at the end of the year. This event will be posted as a regular golf score. Low net prizes are awarded in each flight.

### BLIND PARTNER

Players will play with anyone of their choice, so a player does not know who her partner is until she has finished play. The gross score will be recorded. Full handicap, on each hole, is used for each player and will be notated on her card. After play, partners are drawn and paired together. The better ball on each hole is used to determine their team score. Winners are the lowest net scores.

### CRIERS DICE

Each player will play 18 holes of stroke play. After play, each player rolls one dice. The number on the dice will indicate how many holes that player can revert her worst holes back to par. (IE: If the player rolls a one, she may only change her worst hole back to par, If the player rolls a five, she may revert her five worst holes back to par, and so on). Total the new score and full handicap is deducted to determine the low net winner. **REMEMBER TO POST YOUR ORIGINAL SCORE FOR HANDICAP PURPOSES.**

### LADIES SUMMER CLASSIC

This is a two-day 36-hole tournament with entering gross scores on the card. Handicaps will be determined per each format played. Each player may partner with another player to become the team. On the first day of play, the **front 9** will be played as an **ALTERNATE SHOT FORMAT**, (combine the two players' handicaps together and divide by two, rounding up if necessary). Both players tee off from each tee and the ball selected must be played, (cannot swap balls and cannot move in the rough or penalty areas). Alternating shots are played until the ball is holed out, posting the gross score shot on each hole. On the **back 9**, these holes will be played as a **BEST BALL FORMAT**, (each player gets 85 % of their handicap). Both ladies play their own ball and record each of their gross scores.

Pairings for the second day of play are determined by the low net scores posted from the first day of play. On the second day of play, the **front 9** will be played as an **AGGREGATE FORMAT**, (each player uses 100% of their own handicap rounding up if necessary). Both players play their own ball and record each of the gross scores on each hole. To determine the team's gross scores on each hole, combine them together for the team's score. On the **back 9**, these holes will be played as a **SCRAMBLE FORMAT**, (both handicaps are added together and 25% of the handicap is used for the team handicap. Both players tee off on each tee, then select the best drive and both play from that spot. They will continue with this format until the ball is holed out and enter their gross score for each hole.

### LOTTO

Each player will play 18 holes of stroke play. At the finish of play each player will draw, from a bag, 12 balls which shows the hole-numbers she must circle on her scorecard. She will total the score and deduct two-

thirds of the handicap to determine her final score. The winners are the players with the lowest score for the 12 holes drawn.

## **LOW NET**

Play will be 18-holes of stroke play. The full handicap is deducted at the end of play. Net prizes will be awarded. This will be played by the members who did not qualify to compete in the Ace of Aces.

## **MEMBER-MEMBER ALTERNATING SHOTS**

Each member will team with another member. Both partners will hit a drive off each tee and select which drive to use. The ball selected must be played until holed out (cannot swap balls). Alternating shots are played until the ball is holed out. Both players' handicaps are combined, and then divided by 2 to determine the team handicap. Low net prizes will be awarded.

## **MEMBER-MEMBER (6-6-6)**

Each member will team with another member posting the low gross score on each of the 18 holes played. **The first six holes (holes # 1-6)** will be a Captain's Choice. Each member will tee off and select the best drive. Each member will hit from there and select the next best shot, etc., until the ball is holed out. (If a ball is chosen in the rough, sand or penalty area, it must be played from that position). **The second six holes (holes #7-12)** will be played as a better ball of the two-some (the lowest gross score for either partner will be entered). **The third and last six holes (#13-18)** will be played by alternating shots. Both partners drive from each tee and select which ball to play thereafter. Alternating shots are played until the ball is holed out. The ball selected must be played until holed out (cannot swap balls). Both players' handicaps are combined, and then divided by 2 to determine the team handicap. Low net prizes will be awarded.

## **SCRAMBLE**

A three-lady team will be combined using an "A", "B", and "C", player. The format will be a Captain's Choice. The captain will select the best drive and all players will play from the same spot. If a ball is chosen in the rough, a sand trap or penalty area, it must be played from that position. Proceed with this format until a ball is holed out. The low gross team prizes will be awarded.

## **SELECTED SCORES**

This is a 36-hole event played within a two-week period. The player can pick any two of the four dates scheduled (Wednesday, Saturday, Wednesday, Saturday) but must be played over two weeks and be declared before play begins. The participant plays 18-hole stroke play recording her score on each hole played. After the second round is played, she compares the scores recorded on each hole. She then selects the lowest score posted from each of the eighteen holes. Full handicap is deducted from the total of the holes selected. Low net prizes will be awarded.

## **STEP ASIDE SCRAMBLE**

A three-lady team will be combined by using an "A", "B", or "C" player. The format will be everyone drives off each tee. The captain will select the best drive and whoever's shot is used will step aside and the other two players will hit the next shot from that position. Two Ladies will always be playing. Proceed with this format until a ball is holed out. The low gross team prizes will be awarded.

## **TRICK OR TREAT**

**You will be playing A Captain's Choice for the team score. Your team will be given a Trick or Treat box with 18 different trick or treat instructions listed. On each tee, a player will draw out from the box, a trick or treat clue. All teams have the same trick or treat instructions in their boxes, but based on how they are drawn, all will play differently, which is the 'LUCK or UN-LUCK of the Trick or Treat tournament... "PICK WISELY AND ENJOY"**

**ACE OF ACES** (Major Tournament Posted as Competition Play)

At the end of the season, the Ace of Aces tournament will be played. All 6 monthly winners will compete in this tournament and if a monthly winner cannot compete, then the runner-up for that month will qualify to take her place. There will always be 6 ladies competing. Full handicap is used. The winners are overall low net and a runner-up. **\*\*Ties (See ties of Major Tournaments)\*\***

**FOUNDER'S CUP** (Major Tournament Posted as Competition Play)

The format consists of two (2) consecutive days of stroke play with 3 flights. The first day pairings are done by handicap and the second day of pairings are made up by the first-round net scores. The total of the two rounds will be combined and full handicap will be deducted to determine the winners. This is a low net tournament. We will have winner and a runner-up. Other net prizes will be awarded in each flight according to participation. **\*\*Ties (See ties of Major Tournaments)\*\***

**MEMBER-GUEST** (Special Paid Tournament)

The Member-guest Chairman will announce the format of play. Foursomes are made up of two members of the MLGA and two female guests who do not belong to the Montclair Country Club. Prizes are awarded as follows: 1st Low Net; 1st Low Gross with additional net prizes awarded in order until the prizes are exhausted. A continental breakfast will be provided before play and lunch will be served following play. The entry fee also includes the price of the cart. **ENTRY FEE.**

**MLGA CHAMPIONSHIP** (Major Tournament Posted as Competition Play)

Play will consist of two (2) consecutive days, 36 holes of stroke play. Participants will be flighted according to their handicaps on the first day of play. The second-round pairings are flighted according to their gross scores posted on the first day of play. All participants are eligible to be the MLGA Champion or Runner-Up regardless of flight, which will be determined by the two-day cumulative gross score. Other low gross prizes are awarded in each flight according to participation. **\*\*Ties (See ties of Major Tournaments)\*\***

**PRESIDENT'S PLATE** (Major Tournament Posted as Competition Play)

The format consists of two (2) consecutive days of stroke play. The first day pairings are done by handicap and the second day of pairings are made up by the first-round net scores. The total of the two rounds will be combined and full handicap will be deducted to determine the winners. This is a low net tournament. We will have winner and a runner-up. Other low net prizes will be awarded. **\*\*Ties (See ties of Major Tournaments)\*\***

**SPRING HANDICAP** (Major Tournament Posted as Competition Play)

The format consists of two (2) consecutive days of stroke play. The first day pairings are done by handicap and the second day of pairings are made up by the first-round net scores. The total of the two rounds will be combined and full handicap will be deducted to determine the winners. This is a low net tournament. We will have winner and a runner-up. Other low net prizes will be awarded according to participation. **\*\*Ties (See ties of Major Tournaments)\*\***
